

Dec. 27 or 28 (TBA) Depart the USA. Depart the USA for Dubai. Your flight includes meals, drinks, and in-flight entertainment.

Dec. 29 and 30 Dubai. Arrive in Dubai, the commercial center of the United Arab Emirates, on Dec. 29 and transfer to your "floating hotel," *Celestyal Journey*. Unpack once and settle into your cabin for seven dreamy days. Dubai is a cosmopolitan yet exotic city and you have ample time to explore! A guided city tour may take you to the **Dubai Museum**, housed in the **Al Fahidi Fort** and to the **Juneir Mosque, Dubai's most-photographed structure, and renowned souks (open air markets, specializing in gold)**. Other excursions can include **four-wheel-drive adventures in the desert**, visits to **Bedouin camps, and an opportunity to ride a camel**. Your ship sets sails on December 30 at 4:00 p.m.

Dec. 31 Sir Bani Yas Island, UAE. 9:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. Sir Bani Yas is the largest island of the UAE and is the home of the Arabian Wildlife Park. This park is a safe haven for thousands of wild, free-roaming animals such as the Arabian oryx, sand gazelle, Sudan cheetah, Urial sheep, striped hyena, giraffe and many more. Travelers can **embark on a game drive, nature walk, mountain bike, or horseback ride** to experience all that Sir Bani Yas has to offer. There are also water activities, for those who want to get their feet wet. **Dive in for a snorkeling tour or pearl dive, head out for a deep sea fishing experience, or grab a paddle board and kayak for a glimpse at some more unique indigenous animals.** Due to its conservation efforts, the island has become an important sanctuary for animals, and a spectacular spot for travelers to admire. ***Imagine dinner conversation tonight, on New Year's Eve, sharing stories at your table of what you've seen today and raising a toast to 2025!***

Jan. 1 Abu Dhabi, UAE. 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Prior to the discovery of oil in 1958, Abu Dhabi was basically a poor, rural wasteland. Abu Dhabi now has one of the highest per-capita incomes in the world. The emirate is characterized by three political or geographic divisions: Abu Dhabi City, Al Ain and the offshore islands. Abu Dhabi City, seat of government of the UAE and the nation's largest city (pop. 243,000), is quite modern and clean. Date palms, nestled between the glass and steel high-rises, give the city a taste of soul, but it is still primarily an administrative center. The city also has an **attractive park with beautiful flower gardens and a 2,200-year-old tomb, known as the Round Structure**.

Jan. 2 Bahrain. 11:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Bahrain, a sovereign state, is located on an archipelago consisting of 33 islands, which are low-lying and rocky, with the exception of Bahrain Island, which rises to an elevation of 443 feet in its center. Bahrain's unique features include **170,000 "tumuli" or burial mounds**, Bahrain Fort with foundations dating from 3000 B.C. and the 7th century Khathe Mosque, the oldest in the Gulf.

Jan. 3 Doha, Qatar. 8:00 a.m.-11:00 p.m. Doha is the capital of Qatar and home to more than 80% of the population of this small, wealthy nation on the Arabian Peninsula. **The city hosts several museums showcasing the country's heritage and proud history, as well as traditional art.** Visitors can take in the city and its seaside parks along the **Corniche**, a waterfront road popular with locals and foreigners alike. Because Doha contains a large number of expatriates from around the world, **restaurants offering almost any type of cuisine can be found in the city.** Doha is also the primary headquarters of Al-Jazeera, the influential Arab-language television network.

Jan. 4 At Sea. Enjoy the many amenities of your cruise ship during your restful day at sea.

Jan. 5 Dubai/USA Transfer to the airport for your departure flight. Arrive back to the U.S. the same day
